



Quick Start for Spy Sweeper 6.1

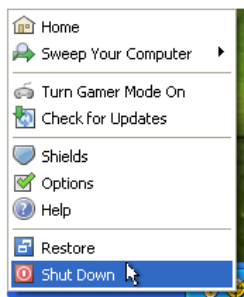
This *Quick Start* describes how to install and begin using Webroot Spy Sweeper, version 6.1. This award-winning software can be used alongside your antivirus security for maximum protection. Whether you need to remove an infection or prevent future attacks, Spy Sweeper provides highly effective protection against spyware, Trojans, rootkits, and keyloggers.



Installing the Webroot software

Follow the instructions below to install the software or upgrade it from a previous version.

Note about upgrading: If you are upgrading from a previous version of the Webroot software, do *not* uninstall your existing version. By installing the new version over the existing one, you can retain the quarantine information from previous sweeps and automatically retain your program settings. Before you begin with the instructions below, shut down your existing version by right-clicking the Webroot system tray icon, then selecting “Shut-down” from the pop-up menu.



To install the program:

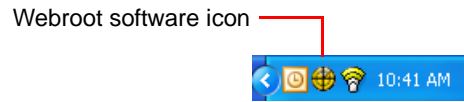
1. Close all programs that may be open on your computer.
2. Start the installation routine either from a CD or from a downloaded file:
 - If you are installing from a CD, insert the CD into the CD drive. An installation screen opens, where you can click **Begin Installation**. If the installation screen does not open, use Windows Explorer to navigate to your CD drive and double-click the software’s installation file.
 - If you are installing from a downloaded file, navigate to where you downloaded the file in Windows Explorer and double-click the file to start the installation. Click **Run** to begin.

The Welcome screen opens. The program will guide you through the installation process.

3. When the final installation screen opens and prompts you to restart the computer, select **Yes** to restart so you can fully activate Webroot software protection. If you do not, the Webroot shields cannot protect against potential threats.

After the system reboots, the Webroot software runs automatically when Windows starts. Look for the Webroot software icon in the Windows system tray in the lower-right corner of your screen. This icon indicates that the Webroot software is running and actively protecting your computer.



Running the Webroot software

After completing the installation and setup, read the following information about running the Webroot software.

Opening the Main window

You can open the Webroot software's Main window by doing one of the following:

- Double-click the Webroot software icon in the system tray (🌐) or right-click the icon and select **Home** from the pop-up menu.
- Double-click the Webroot software icon on your Windows desktop or select the Webroot software from the Windows **Start** menu. (Use this method if the program is not running in the system tray at Windows start-up.)

To learn more about the software, click the **Help** icon (❓) from the Webroot software's Main window.

Using trial versions

For Scan-Only versions, a **Subscribe** button is displayed in the top, red banner of the Main window. For Full Trial versions, a **Buy Now** button is displayed. When you're ready for a subscription version of the Webroot software, connect to the Internet and click one of those buttons to open the Webroot Web site and purchase a subscription.

Using multiple accounts

If your computer is configured for multiple user accounts (each person logs in with a unique name and password), the Webroot program is available to all those accounts. Users with administrative privileges have full access to all areas of the Webroot software, while other users have limited access.
